Regardless of the level of your corporate partnership, every corporate participant must meet the standard requirements of

RRFH in their own right. Please explain this to your team as there are no exceptions. This means: the RRFH registration form must be completed and signed by each participant, individual participants must meet the required fundraising minimum, corporate teams may have cyclists and runners, corporate team must meet the the fundraising minimum of the total number of people on the team (e.g. 5 x \$500 = \$2,500).

Friday, March 12, 2021

The weekend begins with our traditional High Carb Dinner (complimentary to all registered participants). Mix, mingle, and carb load with your fellow cyclists and runners, supporters, friends and volunteers. Guest tickets are available for purchase.

Saturday, March 13, 2021

Event day! Participants meet at the stunning staging area at La Bougainvillea for a complimentary continental breakfast and event briefing. Then they are off, heading out on an out-and-back course. They return to the staging area throughout the day. The staging area becomes an all-day festival affair where everyone can relax and enjoy great camaraderie. Dinner (complimentary to all registered participants) is served as the sun sets, while live music and laughter fills the air.

Sunday, March 14, 2021

Before you head home, a great Bahamian breakfast at Governor's Harbour's famed Buccaneer Club is available from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. Tickets are complimentary for participants and additional tickets for guests can be purchased at packet pick-up. The Buccaneer Breakfast is a perfect way to end your Ride & Run for Hope weekend.
